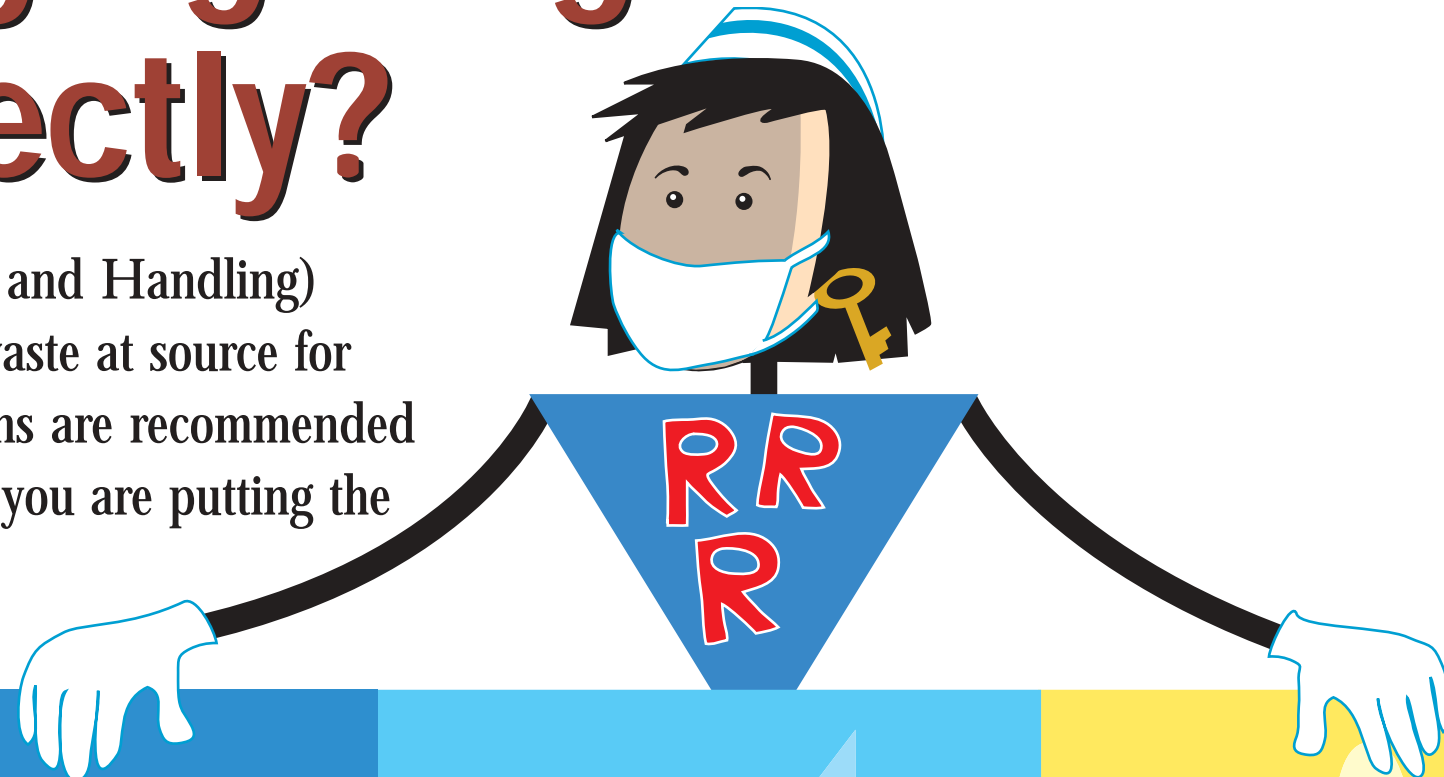


Are you segregating waste correctly?
