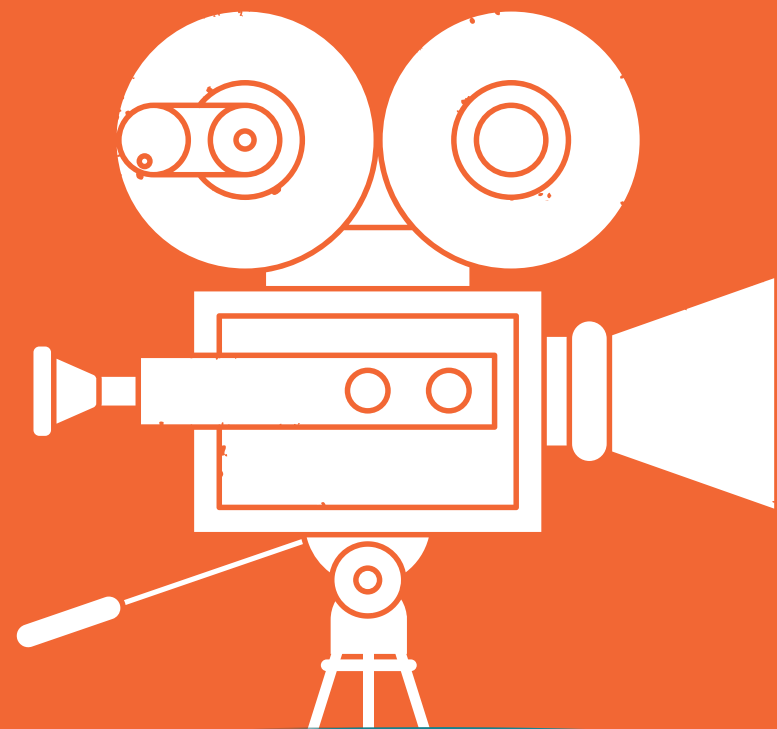

THE SUBJECT

Environmental degradation has become one of the major factors causing serious impact to ecosystem and human health,

We start the screenings with a short film about Uday Tukaram Mandrekar, a boatman who lives on the island of Chorao and shares his abiding passion for preserving the mangrove eco-system with locals and visitors alike, in **The Birdman of Chorao**.

Gyamo, The Pangti Story and **The World's Most Famous Tiger** (the closing film) are about the perilous state of our Endangered Wildlife.

PM 2.5, Living Toxic, Toxics Trail, The Silent Epidemic, Taming the Teesta & Smog Wars communicate dire warnings about human activities that have a destructive impact on ourselves and our natural resources. **Global Warning - Kashmir** is about the effect of Climate Change on one enterprising farmer.

In **Every Drop Counts, Missing** and **India's Healing Forests**, we have positive stories of the fight back against Climate Change and rampant Environmental degradation.

We believe that being aware and collectively changing our behaviour may help us safely cross this intersection of 'Cause and Effect' that we now find ourselves in.
