E-waste is end-of-life electrical and electronic equipment. It is dangerous because it contains a cocktail of toxics - Lead, Mercury & Cadmium to name just a few.

What should I do?

Reduce e-waste by using products longer.

Maintain them properly and Upgrade rather than buy new. **Reuse** old electronics by passing them on to friends,
