

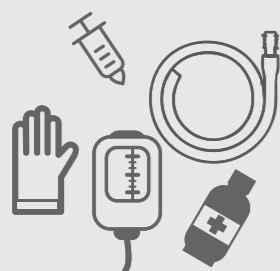

WASTE SEGREGATION

1. Contaminated Waste

Disposable items: Tubing, bottles, IV Sets, catheters, vaccutainers, urine bags, syringes and gloves.



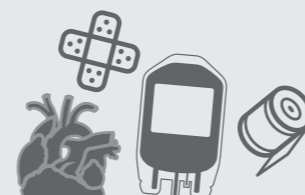
2. Glassware

Broken/discarded/contaminated glass including medicine vials and ampoules (not contaminated with Cytotoxic drugs) and Metallic body implants.



3. Anatomical, Laboratory, Pharmaceutical and Infectious Waste

Human and Animal Anatomical Waste (Tissues, organs & body parts), placenta, foetus, Soiled Waste (blood soaked dressings, cotton swabs, plaster casts & blood bags with blood components), microbiological & biotechnological waste, Pharmaceutical, Cytotoxic waste (And all Cytotoxic contaminated items), linen, mattresses & beddings.



4. Sharps

Needles, syringes with fixed needles, needles from needle tip cutter/burner, scalpel, blade, waste metal sharps.
